The quotations should be dropped in the Tender Box kept at Gate No. 5, Shram Shakti Bhawan, New Delhi. The cover should be prominently super scribed with the words "QUOTATION FOR PURCHASE OF CONDEMNED VEHICLE FOR SCRAP PURPOSES". The vehicle will be available for inspection on 2nd and 3<sup>rd</sup> November, 2010 between 11.00 AM to 4.00 PM. The bidders or their representative (not more than one) may be present, if they so desire, at the time of opening of quotation.

## 4. The sale will be governed by the following conditions:

- (i) The bidder is required to pay Earnest Money of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) payable by means of Demand Draft drawn in favour of Pay and Accounts Officer, Ministry of Power, New Delhi.
- (ii) Quotations received without Earnest Money will not be considered and shall not be accepted.
- (iii) The successful bidder will be required to deposit the bid amount by means of cash/demand draft drawn in favour of Pay and Accounts Officer, Ministry of Power, New Delhi within two working days of the receipt of the communication to this effect from this Ministry.
