

## Summary report for council of ministers on important developments in Power sector during the month of April, 2024

Important issues/developments in respect of Ministry of Power for the Month of April, 2024 are reported as under:

### Generation Performance during the month of April, 2024:

- I. The **total electricity generation** in the country during the month of April, 2024 was 1,53,765 MUs as against the generation of 1,40,548 MUs during the corresponding period last year, showing a growth of 9.40%.
- II. The electricity generation from **Fossil Fuel Power Plants** (Thermal) during April, 2024 was 1,23,504 MUs as against the generation of 1,11,573 MUs during the corresponding period last year, showing a growth of 10.69%.
- III. Due to shortfall in monsoon rains, the country level reservoir storage in April, 2024 was lower as compared to April, 2023. As a result, overall hydro generation in April, 2024 was 8.43% less as compared to April, 2023.
- IV. The Coal receipt/consumption and Coal Stock position for Thermal Power Plants in April, 2024 versus April, 2023 is:-

- V. In April, 2024, Average Biomass co-fired in NCR coal based TPPs is 2687 Tonnes Per Day (TPD), which is ~43% of the biomass co-firing target.
  - VI. In the month of April, 2024, against a target of 600 Ckm, stringing of 179 Ckm transmission lines were completed and further against the target of 1300 MVA, Transformation Capacity of 1960 MVA has been completed. The achievement in respect of transmission lines (220 kV & above) was less in comparison to the target for the month of April, 2024 as work got delayed due to various reasons like RoW issues, standing crop issues, connected substation work not completed etc, as reported by the utilities.
