Summary report for council of ministers on important developments in Power sector during the month of July, 2023

Important issues/developments in respect of Ministry of Power for the Month of July, 2023 are reported as under:

Generation Performance during the month of July, 2023:

- (i) The **total electricity generation** including generation from renewable sources in the country during the month of July 2023 was 1,47,621 MU as against the generation of 1,38,078 MU during the corresponding period last year, showing a growth of 6.91%.
- (ii) The electricity generation from **Fossil Fuel Power Plants** (Thermal) during July 2023 was 1,03,126 MU (showing a growth of 9.29%) during the corresponding period last year,
- (iii) The electricity generation from **Non-Fossil Fuel Power Plants** during July 2023 has increased by 1.77% over same period last year. Share of generation from Non-Fossil Fuel in total generation has been 30.1% during the month of July 2023.
- (iv) In the month of July, 2023, against a target of 2132 Ckm, stringing of 531 Ckm transmission lines were completed. Less achievement in respect of transformation line is because of the work hampered due to heavy rain and non-availability of equipment such as tower parts and conductor. In the month of July, 2023 against the target of 7970 MVA Transformation Capacity of 2600 MVA has been completed. Due to delay in supply of equipment, target of transformation capacity could not be achieved.
- (v) The Coal receipt/consumption and Coal Stock for TPPs monitored in July, 2023 vis-a-vis TPPs monitored in July, 2022 in Daily Coal report are as under:
