## Summary report for council of ministers on important developments in Power sector during the month of MAY, 2022

### 1. Important policy decisions taken, and major achievements during the month

- I. The total electricity generation including generation from renewable sources in the country during the month of May 2022 was 1,44,348 MU as against the generation of 1,18,348 MU during the corresponding period last year, showing a growth of 22.0%.
- II. Overall Renewable Generation (Including Hydro) has increased by 33.0% during May 2022 as compared to last year during same period.
- III. In May, 2022, against a target of 1940 Ckm, stringing of 842 Ckm transmission lines was completed.
- IV. As on 31st May 2022, 1,615 ULBs have been enrolled and over **1.25 crore** LED street lights have been installed under Street Lighting National Programme (SLNP). Progress in this month: 15,000
- V. LED bulbs distributed under UJALA as on 31.05.2022 are 36.86 crore. Progress in this month: 6,22,867
- VI. Implementation of National Smart Grid Mission projects:
  - a) EFC Meeting on continuation of MoP schemes held under Chairmanship of Secretary, MoF on 30th May 2022.
  - b) Chandigarh Sub Division 5 project nearing completion; So far 24,149 smart meters installed excluding 61 Feeder Meters and closure activities in progress.
  - c) 1,540 Smart Meters installed in May 2022 in Rajasthan Smart Grid project, and so far 1,14,608 smart meters installed. Utility requested for approval to change site locations due to consumer/field restrictions.
  - d) Regular compilation of smart meters installation data and updation on NSGM web portal. As of May 2022, approx. 44 lakh smart meters deployed and about 68 lakh smart meters are under deployment in the country across various schemes/states.
