Sub: Procurement of aggregated Power of 2500 MW for three years (covered under medium term) through PFC Consulting Limited as Nodal Agency – Pilot Scheme II.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to inform that Central Government vide its Gazette notification dated 10th April, 2018 issued Guidelines for Procurement of Power 2500 MW under the Pilot Scheme for the period of 3 (three) years (covered under medium term). In this regard, for implementation of Pilot Scheme, Model Pilot Bidding Documents were also issued on 6th April, 2018. Based on the experience gained from the Pilot scheme, wherein 1900 MW power has been tied up, the Central Government has now decided to introduce Pilot Scheme-II to facilitate procurement of aggregated power of 2500 MW power for the period of 3 (three) years (covered under medium term) from the generating companies having coal based Power Plants which are already commissioned without having a power purchase agreement for the quantum of power the Bidder is willing to bid. The proposed scheme also envisages procurement of power through competitive bidding process to be conducted by the PFC Consulting Limited (PFCCL) as the Nodal Agency. Further, in order to facilitate the procurement and supply of power between the Successful Bidder(s) and Distribution Licensee(s), an Aggregator may be appointed by the Nodal Agency. The Aggregator will sign an Agreement for Procurement of Power with the Successful Bidder(s) and back to back Power Supply Agreement with the Distribution Licensee(s). The Scheme is hereinafter referred to as the “**Pilot Scheme -II**”.

2. In order to introduce the above mentioned Pilot Scheme-II for procurement of aggregated power of 2500 MW for three years under medium term(3 years), (i) **Bidding Document for Pilot Scheme-II**; (ii) **Draft Agreement for Procurement of Power under Pilot Scheme-II(APPP-II)**; and (iii) **Draft Power Supply Agreement under Pilot Scheme-II(PSAP-II)** (collectively, the “**Bidding Documents**”) are being issued herewith to be adopted by the Nodal Agency for procurement of power from the power producers through a process of open



and transparent competitive bidding through an electronic platform (DEEP e-Bidding Portal). The Guidelines in this regard are being issued separately.

3. The link for the DEEP e-Bidding Portal for bidding under Pilot Scheme-II shall be made available at the website of PFC Consulting Limited (www.pfcclindia.com), and shall also be available on the website of Ministry of Power (www.powermin.nic.in).

4. The soft copies of **Bidding Documents for Pilot Scheme-II** are available at the website of Ministry of Power i.e. www.powermin.nic.in under 'Current Notices'.
