Subject: Directions to RLDCs under Section 37 of the Electricity Act, 2003 for Scheduling of power under the RE bundling scheme dated 12.04.2022.

Sir,

The revised Scheme on 'Flexibility in Generation and Scheduling of Thermal/ Hydro Power Stations through bundling with Renewable Energy and Storage Power' was issued on 12th April 2022. Clause 6.4 of this Scheme provided for replacement of thermal/hydro power of any Generating station with RE Power. In the context, POSOCO has sought a clarification on the requirement of an additional contract/ agreement for scheduling of power.

The matter has been examined. It is clarified that, RE capacity can be set up anywhere and dispatched to any Generating Station or its beneficiaries. There is no requirement of an additional contract/ agreement for scheduling of power. The power generated from the generating station may be scheduled to procurers under a PPA or sold in the exchange.

The RLDCs are hereby directed, under section 37 of the Act, to give effect to the provisions of Clause 6.4 of the Scheme dated 12 April 2022 and schedule power under the RE bundling scheme.
